1.Revision of the previous meeting minutes	<p>GBV IMS Discussion with the global team is ongoing about how, where and with which partners we can start the process and we will keep you updated about any new feedback.</p> <p>We are currently in touch with the organization that conducted the selfcare training to conduct new training in Gaziantep still pending confirmation of next date.</p>	Minutes endorsed

<p>2. Presentation about Mobile services survey results</p>	<p>The GBV and Child Protection sectors/clusters WoS launched an assessment on mobile service delivery in Syria in April 2017. 70 partners responded to the survey monkey 50% of them from Syrian NGO. 47% from Damascus hub and 37% from Gaziantep (26 Org). Responses to the survey questions will inform the development of standards for GBV and Child Protection actors in order to improve the quality of mobile services and interventions for girls, boys, men and women. Main findings point out that although there is not standard terminology, deliver programming through mobile teams is a common practice. Mobile teams are usually connected to a static facility and are used for emergency responses. <p>3. Adolescent girls strategy debriefing</p>	<p>Brief about the two days consultation on Adolescent girls strategy and how was the discussions during those days and what is the focus of consultants in finalizing the strategy. Partners who attended the consultations also gave SC members brief about how was the meeting for them and what they found useful during the two days. In terms of next steps a first draft of the strategy is finalized. Consultants will have a second visit to Gaziantep in the third week of July. Focus of this mission will be working with health providers mainly on attitudes and believes and also provide the SC with tools and materials to support partners who provide services to adolescent girls. Coordinators will keep the SC members updated about next steps and send invitation emails as appropriate.</p>	

<p>4. Learning corner on GBV and disabilities</p>	<p>Partner facilitated an introductory session on GBV and disabilities. The main focus of the session was challenging the attitudes and beliefs of the service providers about GBV and disabilities through agree don't agree exercise. Each statement was followed by a small discussion about the participants own attitudes and beliefs mainly as service providers. A training tool was introduced to the members in Arabic and English for them to start thinking and working with their teams inside Syria, it is a self-explanatory tool that can be used directly. At next GBV SC meeting there will be a continuation of this learning corner.
